Feedback from visitors to our school

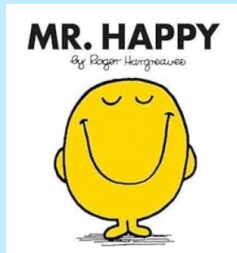
