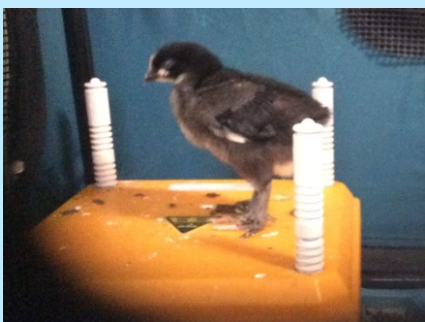

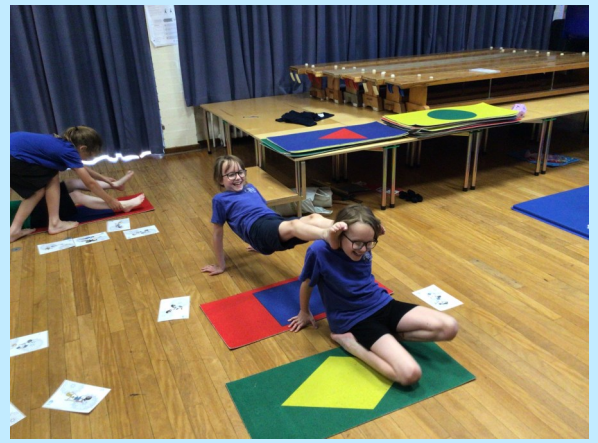

Junior Travel Ambassador



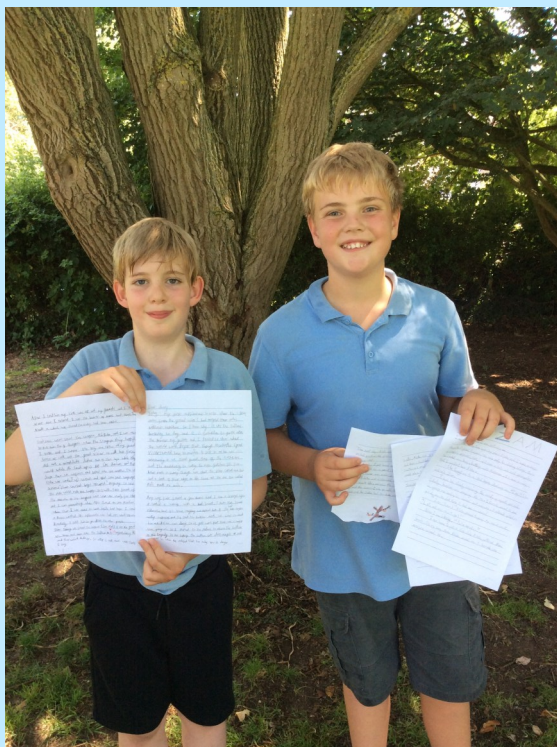

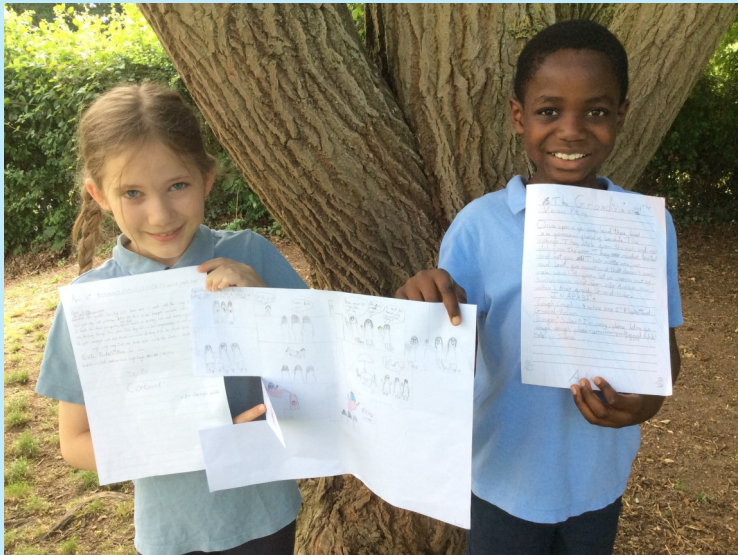
JTA would like to thank you all for your support with the activities and events they have organised this year. Our children are always keen to take part, which is great to see!
