Indoor shoes

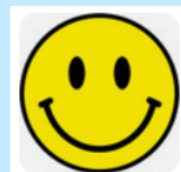
Please can children bring in a pair of indoor shoes to change into e.g. plimsols, rubber soled soft shoes, crocs, etc.
